Judging

The judges will look for quality of work, spur selection, rod selection and time taken.

Competitors must abide by the competition rules and the judge's decision in all cases will be final.

Rules in brief

1. All competitors will prune vines as shown in display bays and as outlined in the competition rules.
2. All entrants must report to the venue at 8.00am for the briefing.
3. Competition starts at 8.30am.
4. Spur pruned vines will be pre-pruned to lift wire height.
5. Rod and Spur vines require previous year's rods to be removed by pruner. Competitors will be penalised if a spur is not retained below the new rod.
6. All prunings must be left within the vicinity of the vine for judging purposes.
7. Secateurs and safety gear including safety glasses are required to be worn during the competition events and to be provided by the competitor.
8. The time taken to complete an event will be recorded for each competitor and points awarded according to how each competitor finishes relative to the fastest time for that event.
9. The judge's decision will be final
